- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Section 521.1015 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 521.1015. PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATE ISSUED
- 9 TO FOSTER CHILD, HOMELESS CHILD OR YOUTH, OR UNACCOMPANIED YOUTH.
- 10 (a) In this section:
- 11 (1) "Foster child" means a person who is 16 years of
- 12 age or older and in the managing conservatorship of the Department
- 13 of Family and Protective Services.
- 14 (2) "Homeless child or youth" has the meaning assigned
- 15 by 42 U.S.C. Section 11434a.
- 16 "Unaccompanied youth" has the meaning assigned by
- 17 42 U.S.C. Section 11434a.
- 18 (b) This section applies to the application for a personal
- 19 identification certificate only for a foster child, a homeless
- 20 child or youth, or an unaccompanied youth.
- 21 (c) Notwithstanding Section 521.101, Section 521.1426, or
- 22 any other provision of this chapter, a child or youth described by
- 23 Subsection (b) may, in applying for a personal identification
- 24 certificate:

- 1 (1) provide a copy of the child's or youth's birth
- 2 certificate as proof of the child's or youth's identity and United
- 3 States citizenship, as applicable; and
- 4 (2) if the child or youth does not have a residence or
- 5 domicile, provide a letter from the school district in which the
- 6 child or youth is enrolled certifying that the child or youth is a
- 7 homeless child or youth or an unaccompanied youth.
- 8 (d) A child or youth described by Subsection (b) may apply
- 9 for and the department may issue a personal identification
- 10 certificate without the signature or presence of or permission from
- 11 a parent or guardian of the child or youth.
- 12 (e) A child or youth described by Subsection (b) is exempt
- 13 from the payment of any fee for the issuance of a personal
- 14 identification certificate under this chapter.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 521.1811, Transportation Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 521.1811. WAIVER OF FEES FOR FOSTER CHILD, HOMELESS
- 18 CHILD OR YOUTH, OR UNACCOMPANIED [CARE] YOUTH. A person is exempt
- 19 from the payment of any fee for the issuance of a driver's license,
- 20 as provided under this chapter, if that person is:
- 21 (1) younger than 18 years of age and in the managing
- 22 conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective
- 23 Services; [<del>or</del>]
- 24 (2) at least 18 years of age, but younger than 21 years
- 25 of age, and resides in a foster care placement, the cost of which is
- 26 paid by the Department of Family and Protective Services; or
- 27 (3) a homeless child or youth or an unaccompanied

- 1 youth as those terms are defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 11434a.
- 2 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an
- 3 application for a driver's license or personal identification
- 4 certificate submitted on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 An application for a driver's license or personal identification
- 6 certificate submitted before the effective date of this Act is
- 7 governed by the law in effect on the date the application was
- 8 submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 9 purpose.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
