## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the suspension of a student who is homeless from public
- 3 school.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.005, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A student who is homeless may not be placed in
- 8 out-of-school suspension. The campus behavior coordinator may
- 9 coordinate with the school district's homeless education liaison to
- 10 identify appropriate alternatives to out-of-school suspension for
- 11 a student who is home<u>less</u>. In this <u>subsection</u>, "student who is
- 12 homeless" has the meaning assigned to the term "homeless children
- 13 and youths" under 42 U.S.C. Section 11434a.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 15 school year.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
