R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The thousands of deaths caused by COVID-19 in Texas  
2 have created a tremendous void in families, communities, and  
3 workplaces throughout the state; among those who lost their lives  
4 in the pandemic was Timothy Beggs, a dedicated and well-respected  
5 employee of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, who passed  
6 away on December 9, 2020, at the age of 61; and

7           WHEREAS, Mr. Beggs was a correctional officer initially  
8 assigned to the Scott Unit in Angleton before moving on to the  
9 Carole Young Medical Facility in Dickinson and later to the Special  
10 Services at Hospital Galveston; in all of his endeavors, he enjoyed  
11 the love and support of his wife of 14 years, Angela, and he took  
12 great pride in their family, which included four children and two  
13 grandchildren; over the course of more than 12 years at the TDCJ,  
14 Mr. Beggs endeared himself to his coworkers with his warm and  
15 friendly nature, delightful sense of humor, and willingness to lend  
16 a helping hand; and

17           WHEREAS, Timothy Beggs faithfully and ably performed his  
18 duties throughout his tenure with the Texas Department of Criminal  
19 Justice, and he will long be remembered with great admiration by all  
20 who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it

21           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas  
22 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the life of  
23 Timothy Beggs and extend deepest sympathy to his family, friends,
