- 2 relating to prohibiting a requirement that a public school student
- 3 receive a coronavirus disease (COVID-19) vaccine.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.001(b), Education Code, as amended by
- 6 Chapters 43 (H.B. 1098) and 94 (H.B. 1059), Acts of the 80th
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is reenacted and amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (b) Subject to Subsections $(b-1)_{,}$ $(b-2)_{,}$ and $(c)_{,}$ the
- 10 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
- 11 may modify or delete any of the immunizations in Subsection (a) or
- 12 may require immunizations against additional diseases as a
- 13 requirement for admission to any elementary or secondary school.
- SECTION 2. Section 38.001, Education Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Subsection (b-2) to read as follows:
- 16 (b-2) A student may not be required, as a condition of the
- 17 student's admission to or continued enrollment in any elementary or
- 18 secondary school, to receive a vaccine for the coronavirus disease
- 19 (COVID-19). An elementary or secondary school is not liable for a
- 20 claim arising from exposure to COVID-19 on the basis that the school
- 21 failed to require a student to receive a COVID-19 vaccine.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 3 legislative session.
