1 WHEREAS, Family and friends will forever treasure their
2 memories of Vandie Lindsey Smith Jr. of Magnolia Springs, who died
3 on July 2, 2021, at the age of 64; and

4 WHEREAS, The son of Vandie Smith Sr. and Lula Bell Smith,
5 Vandie Smith was born in Beaumont on December 15, 1956; he graduated
6 from Kirbyville High School in 1975 and went on to enjoy a career
7 with Temple-Inland and MeadWestvaco that spanned nearly four
8 decades until his retirement; in 1986, he joined the Tri-Community
9 Volunteer Fire Department, rising through the ranks to become the
10 department's chief in 2007 and serving in that position until the
11 end of his life; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Smith shared a rewarding 45-year marriage with
13 his wife, Myrtha, and he was a devoted father to their four
14 children, Vandie, Shanta, Bryan, and Brent; later in life, he took
15 great pride in welcoming into his family 10 grandchildren and 2
16 great-grandchildren; and

17 WHEREAS, Affectionately known as "Uncle Len," Mr. Smith
18 delighted in the time he spent with his loved ones, and he was a
19 Little League coach for many years; he also enjoyed hunting,
20 fishing, farming, and traveling; an active member of Magnolia
21 Springs Church of God in Christ, he served the congregation as
22 deacon; and

23 WHEREAS, Vandie Smith lived a rich and purposeful life
24 devoted to his family, his community, and his faith, and he leaves

1 behind a record of service that will continue to inspire all those
2 who knew and loved him; now, therefore, be it
