6 2012, Mr. Moser made vital contributions to Kerr County during his
7 eight years in office; his many accomplishments include developing
8 the East Kerr/Center Point Wastewater Collection System,

10 position, and extending the City of Kerrville's emergency medical
11 services to the entire county; moreover, he helped the
12 Kerrville-Kerr County Airport achieve financial autonomy in his
13 role as a liaison commissioner; and

15 industry, serving in management positions with NASA's Johnson Space
16 Center and the Texas Aerospace Commission; he holds a bachelor's
17 degree in mechanical engineering from The University of Texas and a

19 Pennsylvania, and he has undertaken doctoral studies at Rice
20 University; and

22 immeasurably by the efforts of skilled and committed public
23 officials, and Tom Moser may indeed take pride in his record of
24 service to Kerr County; now, therefore, be it
