1 WHEREAS, The thousands of deaths caused by COVID-19 in Texas
2 have created a tremendous void in families, communities, and
3 workplaces throughout the state; among those who lost their lives
4 in the pandemic was Alfredo Jimenez Jr., a dedicated and
5 well-respected employee of the Texas Department of Criminal
6 Justice, who passed away on January 15, 2021, at the age of 71; and

7 WHEREAS, Alfredo Jimenez was born in San Angelo on January 4,
8 1950; he enjoyed a long career with Cargill before his retirement in
9 2013, and he went on to work at the Formby State Jail for five years;
10 in his leisure time, he delighted in hunting and in taking pictures
11 of his friends and coworkers at gatherings; known for his
12 dedication, kindness, and willingness to help, he earned the
13 lasting respect of his colleagues and fellow citizens alike; and

14 WHEREAS, Alfredo Jimenez faithfully and ably performed his
15 duties throughout his tenure with the Texas Department of Criminal
16 Justice, and he will long be remembered with great admiration by all
17 who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
19 Legislature, 2nd Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the life of
20 Alfredo Jimenez Jr. and extend deepest sympathy to his family,
21 friends, and colleagues; and, be it further
