2 have created a tremendous void in families, communities, and
3 workplaces throughout the state; among those who lost their lives
4 in the pandemic was Troy Morin, a dedicated and well-respected
5 employee of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, who passed
6 away on February 23, 2021, at the age of 53; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Morin worked for two years at the San Antonio
8 Parole Office, and in all his endeavors, he enjoyed the love and
9 support of his family, which includes his parents, two sisters, and
10 three children; on the job, he was known for his outstanding work
11 ethic and willingness to help anyone in need, and his coworkers
12 appreciated his friendly conversation and wonderful sense of humor;

14 WHEREAS, Troy Morin faithfully and ably performed his duties
15 throughout his tenure with the Texas Department of Criminal
16 Justice, and he will long be remembered with great admiration by all
17 who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it
