R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Cenikor Foundation, a nonprofit organization
2 dedicated to helping clients break free from drug and alcohol
3 addiction, is celebrating the 55th anniversary of its founding in
4 2021; and

5 WHEREAS, Operating at nearly a dozen locations throughout the
6 state of Texas, the Cenikor Foundation administers adult and youth
7 recovery programs that are certified by the Commission on
8 Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities; its spectrum of care
9 includes prevention services, short-term residential treatment,
10 outpatient treatment, detoxification services, and a new sober
11 living program, which provide clients with various ways to work
12 toward long-term sobriety while also accommodating their schedules
13 and individual needs; and

14 WHEREAS, Last year, the Cenikor Foundation served close to
15 400 people in the Fort Worth Community; its Fort Worth facility
16 offers inpatient and outpatient detox, prevention, and recovery
17 programs, as well as short-term residential care; and

18 WHEREAS, For over half a century, the Cenikor Foundation has
19 been a critical lifeline for thousands of Texans, including many
20 Fort Worth residents, and this anniversary celebration presents a
21 welcome opportunity to recognize a truly commendable organization;
