R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The BIZPAC political networking organization has  
2 greatly benefited from the contributions of many hardworking  
3 individuals in its efforts to represent the interests of small  
4 business owners in Texas; and

5           WHEREAS, Founded by executive chair Joseph L. Trahan in 2019,  
6 BIZPAC boasts a membership that includes patent holders,  
7 innovators, scientific and medical professionals, captains of  
8 industry, and other leading performers in their fields; as a  
9 unified voice for like-minded business owners, the group advocates
