1 WHEREAS, Texas Terry of Lexington represented his namesake
2 state with great distinction by winning the title in the
3 under-eight division at the 2021 U.S. Kids Golf World Championship
4 tournament, held July 29 to 31 in Southern Pines, North Carolina;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, Competing alongside 120 golfers from around the
7 world, Mr. Terry turned in an exceptional performance, tallying a
8 three-day total of 108 strokes over 27 holes; he opened with a
9 tournament-best round of 34 and followed it up the next day with a
10 38, which placed him in a tie for first place entering the final
11 round; with the crown on the line, he carded a 36 to capture the
12 under-eight championship by one stroke; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Terry's exciting victory followed close on the
14 heels of an impressive showing earlier in the week at the
15 Parent/Child World Championship at Longleaf Golf and Family Club,
16 where he teamed with his father, Jim Terry; the duo recorded a round
17 of 27 that included a remarkable pair of eagles and six birdies to
18 win the one-day event by three strokes; and

19 WHEREAS, Through hard work and an unwavering commitment to
20 excellence, Texas Terry has proven himself one of the best young
21 golfers in the country, and he may reflect with pride on his
22 outstanding accomplishments; now, therefore, be it
