WHEREAS, A lifelong Lubbock resident, John Wilkerson was born 4 5 on December 18, 1934, to John Gordon Wilkerson and Cleo Hankins Wilkerson Bullard, and he grew up with two siblings, Howard and 6 7 Mary; he graduated from Lubbock High School in 1953 and from Baylor University in 1957; dedicated to his alma mater, he went on to serve 8 for 18 years on the Baylor Board of Regents, including as chair, and 9 he presided over the Hankamer School of Business alumni board of 10 11 directors; he also chaired the Baylor Development Council; and

12 WHEREAS, In 1956, Mr. Wilkerson assumed leadership of the Wilkerson Cold Storage Co., and he remained at its helm as chairman 13 14 until his death; under his able leadership, Wilkerson Storage Co. and Wilkerson Properties served an array of commercial 15 and industrial logistics and real estate customers; Mr. Wilkerson 16 belonged to the board of directors of the International Association 17 of Refrigerated Warehouses, and he was instrumental in the growth 18 of the Lubbock community, chairing the Board of City Development, 19 the Lubbock Central Appraisal District, and the Civil Service 20 21 Commission; and

WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Wilkerson enjoyed the love and support of his wife of 63 years, Ruth, and he took great pride in his four children, Gordon, David, Sarah, and Ray, who preceded his
