WHEREAS, In 1956, Mr. Wilkerson assumed leadership of the Wilkerson Cold Storage Co., and he remained at its helm as chairman until his death; under his able leadership, Wilkerson Storage Co. 14 and Wilkerson Properties served an array of commercial and 15 industrial logistics and real estate customers; Mr. Wilkerson belonged to the board of directors of the International Association 17 of Refrigerated Warehouses, and he was instrumental in the growth 18 of the Lubbock community, chairing the Board of City Development, 19 the Lubbock Central Appraisal District, and the Civil Service 20

21 Commission; and WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Wilkerson enjoyed the love 22 23 and support of his wife of 63 years, Ruth, and he took great pride in his four children, Gordon, David, Sarah, and Ray, who preceded his 24
