3 the age of 54; and

4 WHEREAS, Yancy Williams was born in Houston on August 18,
5 1967, to Ed Williams and Henrietta Patterson, and he grew up with
6 the companionship of four siblings, Chadrick, Pattie, Keisha, and
7 Ora; and

9 enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps in 1983 and the Army Reserve in
10 1993; over the course of his military career, he served in
11 Operations Desert Storm, Desert Shield, and Iraqi Freedom; he went

13 Cooperative for 30 years; deeply dedicated to his community, he was
14 also a firefighter with the Livingston Volunteer Fire Department;

17 and support of his wife, Tammy, and he took great pride in his
18 children, Crystal and Yancy; and

19 WHEREAS, Yancy Williams lived a caring and purposeful life,
