

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Arlington Police Department pays tribute to its
2 fallen officers each May during National Police Week with a solemn
3 ceremony at Heroes Park; and

4 WHEREAS, First dedicated on May 17, 2008, Heroes Park is
5 situated near the APD's West Station and the city's Fire Training
6 Center, and it features a tree-lined walkway, a fountain and
7 memorial pool, and the Wall of Honor, which bears the names of those
8 officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty; and

9 WHEREAS, Since 1930, eight police officers have made the
10 ultimate sacrifice while serving the city; these include James E.
11 Johnson, Gary D. Harl, Terry Lynn Lewis, Jerry J. Crocker, Craig
12 Michael Hanking, Joseph Thomas Cushman, Craig Gordon Story, and
13 Jillian Michelle Smith; and

14 WHEREAS, Texans owe an immense debt of gratitude to the men
15 and women of law enforcement who willingly place themselves in
16 harm's way to protect and serve the public, and the Arlington Police
17 Department's annual tribute to its fallen heroes is a fitting
18 remembrance of their sacrifice and devotion to duty; now,
19 therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
21 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby commemorate the Arlington
22 Police Department's annual fallen officers memorial ceremony and
23 extend to the members of the department sincere best wishes for a
