1 WHEREAS, For many years, Grand Prairie has hosted a Cinco de
2 Mayo parade and festival that has become a beloved tradition for
3 residents from all walks of life; and

4 WHEREAS, Cinco de Mayo commemorates May 5, 1862, when the
5 Mexican army achieved victory over French forces at the Battle of
6 Puebla during the Franco-Mexican War; over time, the holiday has
7 grown into a celebration of Mexican culture and heritage, and it has
8 gained a great deal of popularity in Mexican American communities;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, The Cinco de Mayo event in Grand Prairie kicks off
11 with a parade through the city's downtown area and also features an
12 assortment of food and entertainment, including performances from
13 mariachi bands and folklorico dancers; and

14 WHEREAS, Every year, residents and visitors flock to Grand
15 Prairie's Cinco de Mayo celebration to share in the vibrant
16 traditions that help define Mexican culture, and this occasion
17 provides a fitting opportunity to recognize the many ways that the
18 community is enriched by the contributions of Mexican Americans;
19 now, therefore, be it

21 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby commemorate Grand
22 Prairie's Cinco de Mayo Parade and Celebration and extend to its
