- 1 WHEREAS, The untimely passing of Russell Charles Janecka of 2 Victoria on September 30, 2021, at the age of 61, has brought immeasurable sorrow to the friends and loved ones of this admired 3 civic leader; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Russell Janecka was born in Victoria on May 2, 1960, to Maynard and Esterleen Janecka, and he grew up with seven 6 7 siblings, Darrell, Richard, Karen, Jerilyn, Jill, Jean, and Neysa; a graduate of Victoria High School, he enlisted in the U.S. Air 8 9 Force Security Service and trained at the Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center; he subsequently completed a 10 11 four-year tour in Berlin, Germany, where he worked in signal 12 intelligence as a linguist with the 6912th Electronic Security Squadron; along the way, he continued his education at Victoria 13 14 College and the University of Maryland University College Europe campus; and 15 WHEREAS, Following his father's death in 1986, Mr. Janecka
- WHEREAS, Following his father's death in 1986, Mr. Janecka assumed ownership of the Janecka Insurance Agency, where he was assisted by his sister Jill; he advocated for the industry at the state and national levels and served on the Germania Farm Mutual Insurance Association board for more than 30 years; among his achievements, he was a Life Underwriter Training Council Fellow, a certified insurance counselor, and a certified Leadership Fellow for the National Association of Corporate Directors; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Janecka was deeply devoted to his community; he

- 2 Victoria Chamber of Commerce board; furthermore, he was president
- 3 of the Victoria Adult Literacy Council as well as The Gabriel
- 4 Project of the Crossroads, and he helped facilitate the opening of
- 5 the new Bethlehem Maternity Home; for over 15 years, he acted in
- 6 stage productions for the Victoria Ballet Theatre, where he also
- 7 served as president; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Janecka enjoyed the love
- 9 and support of his wife, Gail, with whom he shared a rewarding
- 10 marriage that spanned more than four decades; he took great pride in
- 11 their three children, Robert, Julie, and Kevin, and their two
- 12 grandsons, Elliott and Malcolm; in his leisure time, Mr. Janecka
- 13 pursued a diverse range of hobbies and interests, and he especially
- 14 delighted in taking annual vacations with his family; a man of
- 15 faith, he was a valued congregant of Holy Family Catholic Church,
- 16 and through the years, he participated in numerous ministries; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Although Russell Janecka will be deeply missed, the
- 18 passion, integrity, and generosity with which he lived his life
- 19 will forever inspire all those who had the good fortune to know him;
- 20 now, therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
- 22 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the memory
- 23 of Russell Charles Janecka and extend heartfelt condolences to his
- 24 many relatives and friends; and, be it further
