2 loss felt by the family and friends of Fnan Measho of Houston, who
3 passed away on October 1, 2021, at the age of 18; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on April 27, 2003, Fnan Measho was the
5 cherished son of Leoul Berhe and Mukot Yohannes, and he grew up with
6 the companionship of three younger siblings, Michael, Temesgen, and
7 Milltet; he graduated with the Class of 2021 at Bellaire High
8 School, where he excelled as a member of the track and cross country
9 teams; and

11 as a valet attendant at a local sports bar; he was helping to
12 provide financial support to his family while he studied
13 criminology at the University of Houston-Downtown, and he hoped to
