R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Texas, 87th Legislature, 3rd Called Session, 2021, That House Rule
3 13, Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 52 (the issuance of revenue
6 bonds to fund capital projects at public institutions of higher
7 education, the oversight of certain capital projects at those
8 institutions, and the designation of certain appropriated funds
9 allocated to those institutions) to consider and take action on the
10 following matter:

11 (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(1), is suspended to
12 permit the committee to amend text not in disagreement in SECTION 2
13 of the bill, in added Section 55.1791(a)(5), Education Code, by
14 striking "infrastructure upgrades to address accessibility for
15 persons with disabilities and health and safety issues" and
16 substituting "an Agricultural Multipurpose Education and Training
17 Center".

18 Explanation: This change is necessary to enable The Texas
19 A&M University System to issue revenue bonds to finance an
20 Agricultural Multipurpose Education and Training Center at Texas
21 A&M University--Commerce.

22 (2) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to
23 permit the committee to add text on a matter not included in either
24 the house or senate version of the bill in SECTION 2 of the bill, in

1 added Section 55.1793(a)(2), Education Code, to read as follows:

3 (C) \$52,409,972 for construction of the Sugar
4 Land Academic Building 2;

5 Explanation: This addition is necessary to enable the
6 University of Houston System to issue revenue bonds to finance
7 construction of the Sugar Land Academic Building 2 at the
8 University of Houston.
