- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.110 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.110. WHOLESALE INDEXED PRODUCTS PROHIBITED. (a)
- 8 In this section, "wholesale indexed product" means a retail
- 9 <u>electric product in which the price a customer pays for electricity</u>
- 10 <u>includes a direct pass-through of real-time settlement point prices</u>
- 11 determined by the independent organization certified under Section
- 12 <u>39.151</u> for the ERCOT power region.
- 13 <u>(b) A retail electric provider may not offer a wholesale</u>
- 14 indexed product to a residential customer.
- SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2021, the Public
- 16 Utility Commission of Texas shall adopt any rules necessary to
- 17 enforce Section 39.110, Utilities Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
