- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 25, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 25.902 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 25.902. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN DISCRIMINATION IN
- 8 STUDENT DRESS OR GROOMING POLICY. (a) In this section, "protective
- 9 hairstyle" includes braids, locks, and twists.
- 10 (b) Any student dress or grooming policy adopted by a public
- 11 school, including a student dress or grooming policy for any
- 12 <u>extracurricular activity</u>, may not discriminate against a hair
- 13 texture or protective hairstyle commonly or historically
- 14 associated with race.
- 15 SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 16 amended by adding Section 51.979 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 51.979. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN DISCRIMINATION IN
- 18 STUDENT DRESS OR GROOMING POLICY. (a) In this section:
- 19 (1) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
- 20 <u>assigned by Section 61.003.</u>
- 21 (2) "Protective hairstyle" includes braids, locks,
- 22 and twists.
- 23 (b) Any student dress or grooming policy adopted by an
- 24 institution of higher education, including a student dress or

- 1 grooming policy for any extracurricular activity, may not
- 2 discriminate against a hair texture or protective hairstyle
- 3 commonly or historically associated with race.
- 4 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 21, Labor Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Section 21.1095 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 21.1095. RACIAL DISCRIMINATION BASED ON HAIR TEXTURE
- 7 OR PROTECTIVE HAIRSTYLE. (a) In this section, "protective
- 8 hairstyle" includes braids, locks, and twists.
- 9 (b) A provision in this chapter referring to discrimination
- 10 because of race or on the basis of race includes discrimination
- 11 because of or on the basis of an employee's hair texture or
- 12 protective hairstyle commonly or historically associated with
- 13 race.
- 14 (c) An employer, labor union, or employment agency commits
- 15 an unlawful employment practice if the employer, labor union, or
- 16 employment agency adopts or enforces a dress or grooming policy
- 17 that discriminates against a hair texture or protective hairstyle
- 18 commonly or historically associated with race.
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 21.1095, Labor Code, as added by this
- 20 Act, applies only to an unlawful employment practice that occurs on
- 21 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
