- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the Research Animal
- 6 Retirement Act.
- 7 SECTION 2. Title 10, Health and Safety Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Chapter 830 to read as follows:
- 9 CHAPTER 830. ADOPTION OF CERTAIN RETIRED RESEARCH ANIMALS
- Sec. 830.0001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 11 (1) "Animal rehoming organization" means a nonprofit
- 12 charitable organization established primarily to find adoptive
- 13 homes for animals.
- 14 (2) "Animal shelter" means a facility operated by a
- 15 nonprofit charitable organization established primarily to shelter
- 16 and care for stray, homeless, abandoned, or unwanted animals and
- 17 find adoptive homes for those animals.
- 18 (3) "Executive commissioner" means the executive
- 19 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission.
- 20 (4) "Research facility" means a research facility as
- 21 defined by the Animal Welfare Act (7 U.S.C. Section 2132(e)) that is
- 22 licensed by or registered with the United States Department of
- 23 Agriculture under that Act to conduct experiments on dogs or cats
- 24 for education, research, science, or testing purposes.

- 1 (5) "Retired animal" means a dog or cat previously
- 2 used by a research facility in experiments conducted for education,
- 3 research, science, or testing purposes that is no longer needed for
- 4 those purposes.
- 5 Sec. 830.0002. LIMITATION. This chapter does not apply to a
- 6 retired animal identified by a research facility's attending
- 7 veterinarian as:
- 8 (1) not suitable for rehoming; or
- 9 (2) having a substantial medical condition that
- 10 prevents the animal from successfully integrating into an adoptive
- 11 home.
- 12 Sec. 830.0003. ADOPTION OF RETIRED ANIMALS. (a) A research
- 13 facility, or its authorized employee or an authorized student of an
- 14 institution of higher education associated with the facility, on
- 15 retirement of a retired animal shall offer the animal for adoption:
- 16 (1) through an animal rehoming organization or animal
- 17 shelter; or
- 18 (2) by an individual through an arrangement between
- 19 the facility and individual.
- 20 (b) A research facility may not offer any retired animal to
- 21 an animal rehoming organization or animal shelter unless the
- 22 facility has a written agreement with the organization or shelter
- 23 addressing the transfer of the facility's retired animals to the
- 24 organization or shelter.
- 25 <u>(c) A research facility may establish guidelines for</u>
- 26 determining whether:
- 27 (1) a retired animal is suitable for adoption; and

- 1 (2) an animal rehoming organization, animal shelter,
- 2 or individual is qualified to accept a retired animal for adoption.
- 3 (d) A research facility must post on the facility's Internet
- 4 website any guidelines adopted under Subsection (c).
- 5 Sec. 830.0004. IMMUNITY FROM CIVIL LIABILITY. A research
- 6 facility that in good faith and in compliance with this chapter and
- 7 rules adopted under this chapter provides a research animal to an
- 8 animal rehoming organization, animal shelter, or individual is
- 9 immune from civil liability with respect to a claim based on:
- 10 (1) the facility's transfer of a retired animal to the
- 11 organization, shelter, or individual under this chapter; or
- 12 (2) the adoption of a retired animal by an individual
- 13 through the organization or shelter.
- 14 Sec. 830.0005. RULES. The executive commissioner may adopt
- 15 rules necessary to implement this chapter.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
