BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 32.024, Human Resources Code, is amended

5 by adding Subsection (nn) to read as follows:

6 (nn) The commission shall provide medical assistance

7 reimbursement for services provided by a doula, including

8 childbirth education and emotional and physical support provided

9 during pregnancy, labor, birth, and the postpartum period. The

10 executive commissioner by rule shall determine the qualifications

11 necessary for an individual to be considered a doula and the doula

12 <u>services to be covered under the medical assistance program.</u>

SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act

14 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a

15 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

16 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

17 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the

18 waiver or authorization is granted.

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
