9 SECTION 3. (a) Section 105.06, Alcoholic Beverage Code, as 10 amended by this Act, applies only to an offense committed on or 11 after the effective date of this Act. For the purposes of this 12 section, an offense is committed before the effective date of this 13 Act if any element of the offense occurs before that date.

14 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this 15 Act is covered by the law in effect immediately before the effective 16 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that 17 purpose.
