- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 382.058(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (c) For purposes of this section, only <u>a representative of a</u>
- 9 school, place of worship, licensed day-care center, hospital, or
- 10 medical facility or a person [those persons actually] residing [in
- 11 $\frac{\text{a permanent residence}}{\text{model}}$ within $\frac{880}{\text{model}}$ [440] yards of the proposed plant
- 12 may request a hearing under Section 382.056 as a person who may be
- 13 affected. The commission shall adopt rules establishing who
- 14 qualifies as a representative of a school, place of worship,
- 15 <u>licensed day-care center</u>, hospital, or medical facility under this
- 16 section.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an application for a permit that is submitted to the Texas
- 19 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date
- 20 of this Act. An application for a permit that was submitted to the
- 21 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality before the effective date
- 22 of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 23 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 24 that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

5 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
