1-17 relating to the continuation of the Red River Boundary Commission.  
1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-19 SECTION 1. Section [12.057\(b\)](#), Natural Resources Code, is  
1-20 amended to read as follows:  
1-21 (b) Not later than July 30, 2023 [~~2021~~], the commission  
1-22 shall issue a final report to the governor, lieutenant governor,  
1-23 speaker of the house of representatives, and appropriate committees  
1-24 of the legislature.  
1-25 SECTION 2. Section [12.058](#), Natural Resources Code, is  
1-26 amended to read as follows:  
1-27 Sec. 12.058. EXPIRATION OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter  
1-28 expires December 31, 2023 [~~2021~~].  
1-29 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-31 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
