18	(4) [ <del>, Penal Code, or serving a sentence for an offense</del>

22	SECTION 2. Section 508.145(d)(1), Government Code, is

1 serving a sentence for: an offense described by Article 42A.054(a), 2 (A) Code of Criminal Procedure, other than an offense under Section 3 19.03, Penal Code, or an offense under Chapter 20A, Penal Code, that 4 is described by Subsection (a)(1) or (2); 5 6 (B) an offense for which the judgment contains an affirmative finding under Article 42A.054(c) or (d), Code of 7 Criminal Procedure; or 8 9 (C) [an offense under Section 20A.03, Penal Code; 10 <del>or</del> [(D)] an offense under Section 71.02 or 71.023, 11 Penal Code. 12 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 13 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 14 15 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 16 17 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 18 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 19 before that date. 20 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
