1 AN ACT 2 relating to the taking of a blood specimen on arrest for certain 3 intoxication offenses. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 724.012, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subsections (a-1) and (e) and amending Subsections (b) 6 and (c) to read as follows: 7 (a-1) A peace officer shall require the taking of a specimen 8 9 of the person's blood if: (1) the officer arrests the person for an offense 10 under Chapter 49, Penal Code, involving the operation of a motor 11 12 vehicle or a watercraft; 13 (2) the person refuses the officer's request to submit 14 to the taking of a specimen voluntarily; 15 (3) the person was the operator of a motor vehicle or a 16 watercraft involved in an accident that the officer reasonably believes occurred as a result of the offense; and 17 18 (4) at the time of the arrest, the officer reasonably believes that as a direct result of the accident any individual has 19 died, will die, or has suffered serious bodily injury. 20 21 Subject to Subsection (a-1), a [A] peace officer shall

require the taking of a specimen of the person's breath or blood

under any of the following circumstances if the officer arrests the

person for an offense under Chapter 49, Penal Code, involving the

- 1 operation of a motor vehicle or a watercraft and the person refuses
- 2 the officer's request to submit to the taking of a specimen
- 3 voluntarily:
- 4 (1) the person was the operator of a motor vehicle or a

- 4 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), the [The] peace
- 5 officer shall designate the type of specimen to be taken.
- 6 (e) A peace officer may not require the taking of a specimen
- 7 under this section unless the officer:
- 8 <u>(1) obtains a warrant directing that the specimen be</u>
- 9 taken; or
- 10 (2) has probable cause to believe that exigent
- 11 circumstances exist.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 724.013, Transportation Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 724.013. PROHIBITION ON TAKING SPECIMEN IF PERSON
- 15 REFUSES; EXCEPTION. Except as provided by <u>Section 724.012(a-1) or</u>
- 16 (b) [Section 724.012(b)], a specimen may not be taken if a person
- 17 refuses to submit to the taking of a specimen designated by a peace
- 18 officer.
- 19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an arrest that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 An arrest that occurs before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law in effect on the date the arrest occurred, and
- 23 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
