4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 823, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 823.004 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 823.004. NOTICE OF CERTAIN COMMUNICABLE OR INFECTIOUS
8	DISEASES. (a) The department, in consultation with the State Board
9	of Veterinary Medical Examiners, shall develop and the department
10	and board shall each post on the agency's Internet website a model
11	electronic or written notice regarding an animal's possible
12	exposure to a communicable or infectious disease while the animal
13	is in an animal shelter. At a minimum the notice must:
14	(1) warn a person who adopts an animal from a shelter
15	about the animal's possible exposure to common communicable or
16	infectious diseases, the incubation period for those diseases, and
17	the need to monitor the animal for two weeks; and
18	(2) encourage the person to have a veterinariar
19	examine the adopted animal after adoption.
20	(b) An animal shelter may provide the notice developed under
21	Subsection (a) to a person at the time the person adopts an animal
