- 9 SECTION 3. Section 823.010, Health and Safety Code, as
- 10 added by this Act, applies only to the termination of ownership
- 11 interest in an animal adopted from an animal shelter or transferred
- 12 from an animal shelter to an animal rescue organization on or after
- 13 the effective date of this Act. An adoption or transfer that occurs
- 14 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 15 effect immediately before that date, and the former law is
- 16 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
