1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the participation of the medical school at the
 1-20 University of Houston and the college of osteopathic medicine at
 1-21 Sam Houston State University in the Joint Admission Medical
 1-22 Program.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 51.821(4), Education Code, is amended to
 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 (4) "Participating medical school" means each of the
 1-27 following entities:

1-28 (A) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-29 Health Science Center at Houston;

1-30 (B) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-31 Southwestern Medical Center;

1-32 (C) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-33 Health Science Center at San Antonio;

1-34 (D) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-35 Medical Branch at Galveston;

1-36 (E) the medical school at the Texas Tech
 1-37 University Health Sciences Center at Lubbock;

1-38 (F) the medical school at the Texas Tech
 1-39 University Health Sciences Center at El Paso;

1-40 (G) the Baylor College of Medicine;

1-41 (H) the college of osteopathic medicine at the
 1-42 University of North Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth;

1-43 (I) the medical school at The Texas A&M
 1-44 University System Health Science Center;

1-45 (J) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-46 at Austin; ~~and~~

1-47 (K) the medical school at The University of Texas
 1-48 Rio Grande Valley;

1-49 (L) the medical school at the University of
 1-50 Houston; and

1-51 (M) the college of osteopathic medicine at Sam
 1-52 Houston State University.

1-53 SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
 1-54 date of this Act, the medical school at the University of Houston
 1-55 and the college of osteopathic medicine at Sam Houston State
 1-56 University each shall:

1-57 (1) enter into the agreement with the Joint Admission
 1-58 Medical Program Council required by Section 51.829, Education Code;
 1-59 and

1-60 (2) select an appropriate faculty member to represent
 1-61 the respective medical school on the council.

2-1 (b) The medical school at the University of Houston and the
2-2 college of osteopathic medicine at Sam Houston State University
2-3 each shall provide internships and mentoring under the Joint
2-4 Admission Medical Program as appropriate beginning not later than
2-5 the 2022-2023 academic year, but are not required before the
2-6 2023-2024 academic year to admit participating students to the
2-7 school or college under the program.

2-8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-12 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
