1-19 relating to the storage of firearms and ammunition in the same
 1-20 locked location in certain foster homes.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 42.042(e-1), Human Resources Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (e-1) The commission may not prohibit possession of
 1-25 lawfully permitted firearms and ammunition in an agency foster
 1-26 home. Minimum standards may be adopted under this section relating
 1-27 to safety and proper storage of firearms and ammunition. The
 1-28 minimum standards must allow firearms and ammunition to be [~~stored~~
 1-29 ~~separately or~~] stored together in the same locked location [~~if the~~
 1-30 ~~firearms are stored with a trigger locking device attached to the~~
 1-31 ~~firearms~~].

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
