- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 202.018(a) and (b), Property Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a property
- 8 owners' association may not enforce or adopt a provision in a
- 9 dedicatory instrument, including a restrictive covenant, that
- 10 prohibits a property owner or resident from displaying or affixing
- 11 on the [entry to the] owner's or resident's property [dwelling] one
- 12 or more religious items the display of which is motivated by the
- 13 owner's or resident's sincere religious belief.
- 14 (b) This section does not prohibit the enforcement or
- 15 adoption of a provision in a dedicatory instrument, including a
- 16 <u>restrictive</u> covenant, that, to the extent allowed by the
- 17 constitution of this state and the United States, prohibits the
- 18 display or affixing of a religious item on the [entry to the]
- 19 owner's or resident's <u>property</u> [dwelling] that:
- 20 (1) threatens the public health or safety;
- 21 (2) violates a law other than a law prohibiting the
- 22 display of religious speech; or
- 23 (3) contains language, graphics, or any display that
- 24 is patently offensive to a passerby for reasons other than its

- 1 religious content[+
- 2 [(4) is in a location other than the entry door or door
- 3 frame or extends past the outer edge of the door frame of the
- 4 owner's or resident's dwelling; or
- 5 [(5) individually or in combination with each other
- 6 religious item displayed or affixed on the entry door or door frame
- 7 has a total size of greater than 25 square inches].
- 8 SECTION 2. Sections 202.018(c) and (d), Property Code, are
- 9 repealed.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
