- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.0062(a), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Each school district and open-enrollment charter school
- 8 shall:
- 9 (1) provide for the use of a phonics curriculum that
- 10 uses systematic direct instruction in kindergarten through third
- 11 grade to ensure all students obtain necessary early literacy
- 12 skills;
- 13 (2) ensure that:
- 14 (A) not later than the 2023-2024 [$\frac{2021-2022}{2021}$]
- 15 school year, each classroom teacher in kindergarten or first,
- 16 second, or third grade and each principal at a campus with
- 17 kindergarten or first, second, or third grade has attended a
- 18 teacher literacy achievement academy developed under Section
- 19 21.4552; and
- 20 (B) each classroom teacher and each principal
- 21 initially employed in a grade level or at a campus described by
- 22 Paragraph (A) for the 2023-2024 [2021-2022] school year or a
- 23 subsequent school year has attended a teacher literacy achievement
- 24 academy developed under Section 21.4552 before the teacher's or

- 1 principal's first year of placement in that grade level or campus;
- 2 and
- 3 (3) certify to the agency that the district or school:
- 4 (A) prioritizes placement of highly effective
- 5 teachers in kindergarten through second grade; and
- 6 (B) has integrated reading instruments used to
- 7 diagnose reading development and comprehension to support each
- 8 student in prekindergarten through third grade.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
