A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain orders, proclamations, and regulations issued
- 3 in response to a disaster by the governor or the presiding officer
- 4 of the governing body of a political subdivision.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 418.012, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 418.012. EXECUTIVE ORDERS. (a) Under this chapter,
- 9 the governor may issue, amend, or rescind executive orders,
- 10 proclamations, and regulations [and amend or rescind them].
- 11 (b) Executive orders, proclamations, and regulations issued
- 12 by the governor have the force and effect of law.
- 13 (c) To the extent of any conflict, an executive order,
- 14 proclamation, or regulation issued by the governor under this
- 15 chapter prevails over an order, proclamation, or regulation issued
- 16 by the presiding officer of the governing body of a political
- 17 <u>subdivision under this chapter.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
