## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the date of the general primary election to be held in

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 41, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 41.0075 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 41.0075. POSTPONING PRIMARY ELECTION IN SPECIAL
- 8 CIRCUMSTANCE. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
- 9 governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house may, by
- 10 written agreement, postpone the date of the general primary
- 11 election to be held in 2022 if a redistricting plan adopted by the
- 12 <u>legislature or the Legislative Redistricting Board under Section</u>
- 13 28, Article III, Texas Constitution, is not in effect on or before
- 14 September 1, 2021.
- 15 (b) An agreement under Subsection (a) may not be made later
- 16 than the 45th day before the filing deadline described by Section
- 17 172.023.
- 18 <u>(c) As soon as possible after an agreement under Subsection</u>
- 19 (a) is made, the governor shall deliver the agreement to the
- 20 secretary of state and to the state chair of each party that had a
- 21 nominee for a statewide or district office on the general election
- 22 ballot in 2020.
- 23 (d) An agreement made under Subsection (a) must include
- 24 either:

- 1 (1) the date on which the general primary election
- 2 will be held; or
- 3 (2) an agreement that the governor, lieutenant
- 4 governor, and speaker of the house will determine the date of the
- 5 general primary election at a later date.
- 6 (e) The filing period for an election postponed by agreement
- 7 under Subsection (d)(2) may not begin before the 30th day after the
- 8 date a determination is made under that subsection.
- 9 (f) The general primary election may not be postponed under
- 10 this section to a date later than July 1, 2022.
- 11 (g) If the general primary election is postponed under this
- 12 section, the secretary of state shall adjust the date for a runoff
- 13 election, the deadline for filing for candidacy, and the schedule
- 14 for canvassing election returns, declaring results, or performing
- 15 any other official act relating to the election to allow the same
- 16 <u>interval of time in relation to the date of the election as would be</u>
- 17 provided by application of other law.
- 18 (h) This section expires January 1, 2023.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
