 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the general manager of the Upper Colorado River  
 1-20 Authority.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Sections 8506.056(d), (e), and (f), Special  
 1-23 District Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-24 (d) The board may employ a general manager. The general  
 1-25 manager [presiding officer] is the chief executive officer of the  
 1-26 authority. The general manager may not be a member of the board.

1-27 (e) The secretary, secretary pro tem, presiding officer,  
 1-28 general manager, and treasurer have the powers and duties, hold  
 1-29 office for the term, and are subject to removal in the manner  
 1-30 provided by the bylaws.

1-31 (f) The board shall set the compensation of the secretary,  
 1-32 secretary pro tem, presiding officer, general manager, and  
 1-33 treasurer.

1-34 SECTION 2. Section 8506.058(c), Special District Local Laws  
 1-35 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-36 (c) The general manager [presiding officer] is in charge of  
 1-37 the authority's general office.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
