- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 143, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 143.0011 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 143.0011. PARTISAN CANDIDACY REQUIRED. (a) A
- 8 candidate must declare a party affiliation to run for a city office.
- 9 (b) A candidate's party affiliation must appear on the
- 10 ballot next to the candidate's name.
- 11 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 143.003, Election Code,
- 12 is amended to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 143.003. PARTISAN <u>NOMINATION</u> [CANDIDACY] FOR
- 14 HOME-RULE CITY OFFICE AUTHORIZED.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 143.004, Election Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 143.004. APPLICATION REQUIRED. (a) Subject to Section
- 18 143.005, to be entitled to a place on the ballot, a candidate must
- 19 make an application for a place on the ballot.
- 20 (b) An application must state the political party with which
- 21 the candidate is aligned or, if the candidate is not aligned with a
- 22 party, state that fact.
- 23 SECTION 4. Section 143.002, Election Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
