## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the maximum total extended benefit amount payable to an
- ${\tt 3}$  individual under the unemployment compensation system.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 209.062, Labor Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 Sec. 209.062. MAXIMUM TOTAL EXTENDED BENEFIT AMOUNT. The
- 8 total extended benefit amount payable to an eligible individual for
- 9 the individual's eligibility period is 60 [50] percent of the total
- 10 amount of regular benefits that were payable to the individual
- 11 under this subtitle in the individual's applicable benefit year.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to a claim for extended unemployment compensation benefits that is
- 14 filed with the Texas Workforce Commission on or after the effective
- 15 date of this Act. A claim filed before that date is governed by the
- 16 law in effect on the date that the claim was filed, and the former
- 17 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
