- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 6.03, Tax Code, is amended by amending
- 6 Subsection (k) and adding Subsection (k-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (k) Except as provided by Subsection (k-1), the [The]
- 8 governing body of each taxing unit entitled to vote shall determine
- 9 its vote by resolution and submit it to the chief appraiser before
- 10 December 15. The chief appraiser shall count the votes, declare the
- 11 five candidates who receive the largest cumulative vote totals
- 12 elected, and submit the results before December 31 to the governing
- 13 body of each taxing unit in the district and to the candidates. For
- 14 purposes of determining the number of votes received by the
- 15 candidates, the candidate receiving the most votes of the
- 16 conservation and reclamation districts is considered to have
- 17 received all of the votes cast by conservation and reclamation
- 18 districts and the other candidates are considered not to have
- 19 received any votes of the conservation and reclamation districts.
- 20 The chief appraiser shall resolve a tie vote by any method of
- 21 chance.
- 22 (k-1) This subsection applies only to an appraisal district
- 23 <u>established in a county with a population of 120,000 or more. The</u>
- 24 governing body of each taxing unit entitled to cast at least five

- 1 percent of the total votes must determine its vote by resolution
- 2 adopted at the first or second open meeting of the governing body
- 3 that is held after the date the chief appraiser delivers the ballot
- 4 to the presiding officer of the governing body. The governing body
- 5 must submit its vote to the chief appraiser not later than the third
- 6 day following the date the resolution is adopted.
- 7 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to the selection of members of the board of directors of an
- 9 appraisal district who are appointed for a term that begins on or
- 10 after January 1, 2022.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
