9	(1) "Communicable disease" has the meaning assigned by

11	(2) "Highly contagious communicable disease" means a
12	communicable disease that creates a substantial risk of public

- (b) Each school district shall prepare and maintain a health 15 and safety plan for preventing the spread of a highly contagious 16 17 communicable disease at school district campuses. The health and safety plan must include provisions for, if appropriate to prevent 18 19 the spread of the disease:
- 20 (1) providing hand washing schedules for students and 21 school personnel;
- (2) requiring temperature checks for students and 22 23 school personnel;
- 24 (3) requiring classrooms to be arranged to provide for

- 1 physical separation between students' desks based on social
- 2 distancing recommendations by local health officials;
- 3 (4) including sanitation protocols for campus
- 4 facilities;
- 5 (5) maintaining an inventory of personal protection
- 6 equipment and cleaning supplies;
- 7 (6) notifying students, parents, and school personnel
- 8 if a member of the school community receives a positive test result
- 9 for a highly contagious communicable disease;
- 10 (7) including protocols for handling a positive test
- 11 result among members of the school community; and
- 12 (8) including a list of community and school health
- 13 centers and resources available to members of the school community.
- 14 (c) Not later than the beginning of each school year, each
- 15 school district shall:
- 16 (1) review and, if necessary, revise the health and
- 17 safety plan prepared under Subsection (b); and
- 18 (2) submit the district's health and safety plan to the
- 19 agency.
- 20 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 21 of this Act but not later than the beginning of the 2021-2022 school
- 22 year, each school district shall prepare a highly contagious
- 23 communicable disease health and safety plan and submit the
- 24 district's plan to the Texas Education Agency as required by
- 25 Section 38.044, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
