5	SECTION 1. Chapter 250, Transportation Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 250.002 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 250.002. RIGHT-OF-WAY ACCOMMODATION FOR
8	BROADBAND-ONLY PROVIDERS. (a) In this section, "broadband-only
9	provider" means an entity that exclusively provides broadband
10	service, as defined by Section 181.048, Utilities Code.
11	(b) The commission by rule shall:
12	(1) establish an accommodation process that
13	authorizes broadband-only providers to use state highway
14	rights-of-way, subject to highway purposes, for:
15	(A) new broadband facility installations;
16	(B) additions to or maintenance of existing
17	broadband facility installations;
18	(C) adjustments or relocations of broadband
19	facilities; and
20	(D) existing broadband facilities retained
21	within the rights-of-way; and
22	(2) prescribe minimum requirements for the
23	accommodation, method, materials, and location for the
24	installation adjustment and maintenance of broadhand facilities

- 2 SECTION 2. Not later than the first anniversary of the
- 3 effective date of this Act, the Texas Transportation Commission
- 4 shall adopt the rules required by Section 250.002, Transportation
- 5 Code, as added by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
