1-19 relating to the deadline to begin a county fire code inspection in
 1-20 certain counties.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section [233.064](#), Local Government Code, is
 1-23 amended by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (e-1) to
 1-24 read as follows:

1-25 (e) Except as provided by Subsection (e-1), the [The] county
 1-26 shall begin the inspection of the building within five business
 1-27 days after the date of the receipt of the written inspection
 1-28 request. If an inspection is properly requested and the county does
 1-29 not begin the inspection within the time permitted by this
 1-30 subsection, the building that is the subject of the request is
 1-31 considered approved for the purposes of this subchapter.

1-32 (e-1) A county with a population of more than 3.3 million
 1-33 shall begin the inspection of the building within 10 business days
 1-34 after the date of receipt of the written inspection request.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
