A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of a registry for and requiring the
3	registration of certain unmanned teller machines; imposing a fee;
4	providing a civil penalty.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle Z, Title 3, Finance Code, is amended by
7	adding Chapter 282 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 282. REGISTRATION OF UNMANNED TELLER MACHINES
9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 282.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Department" means the Texas Department of
12	Banking.
13	(2) "Finance commission" means the Finance Commission
14	of Texas.
15	(3) "Financial institution" has the meaning assigned
16	<u>by Section 201.101.</u>
17	(4) "Occupant," with respect to an unmanned teller
18	machine, means a person who permits the public to access and use the
19	machine on the premises of a business establishment or facility
20	owned or operated by the person.
21	(5) "Operator," with respect to an unmanned teller
22	machine, means a person that owns, leases, operates, or maintains

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the machine for public use on the premises of a business

establishment or facility owned or occupied by another person.

- 1 (6) "Registration sticker" means the sticker issued
- 2 under Section 282.055(b) that is required to be placed on an
- 3 unmanned teller machine as proof of the machine's registration
- 4 under this chapter.
- 5 "Unmanned teller machine" has the meaning assigned
- 6 by Section 59.301.
- 7 Sec. 282.002. INAPPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER TO CERTAIN
- 8 UNMANNED TELLER MACHINES. This chapter does not apply to an
- 9 unmanned teller machine that is:
- 10 (1) installed, maintained, owned, or operated by a
- 11 financial institution or an affiliate of a financial institution;
- 12 (2) located or operated in another state; or
- 13 (3) not available for public use.
- 14 Sec. 282.003. RULES. The finance commission shall adopt
- 15 rules necessary to administer, implement, and enforce this chapter.
- 16 SUBCHAPTER B. REGISTRATION OF UNMANNED TELLER MACHINES; REGISTRY
- 17 Sec. 282.051. UNMANNED TELLER MACHINE REGISTRY. (a) The
- 18 department shall establish and maintain on the department's
- 19 Internet website an online registry of unmanned teller machines
- 20 required to be registered under this chapter.
- 21 (b) The department shall update the registry at least
- 22 quarterly.
- 23 <u>Sec. 282.052. REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN UNMANNED TELLER</u>
- 24 MACHINES REQUIRED. Before operating an unmanned teller machine in
- 25 this state, the operator of the machine must:
- 26 (1) register the machine; and
- 27 (2) place a valid registration sticker on the machine.

Sec. 282.053. APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION. (a) To 1 2 register an unmanned teller machine, the operator of the machine must file an application with the department in accordance with 3 4 this chapter. 5 (b) An operator may apply to register one or more unmanned teller machines in the same application. 6 7 (c) The registration application must: 8 (1) be in writing and notarized; 9 (2) be completed by the operator of the machine; (3) include for each unmanned teller machine the 10 operator is applying to register: 11 12 (A) the name, address, and telephone number of the facility or place of business where the unmanned teller machine 13 14 will be located; 15 (B) the name, address, and telephone number of 16 the occupant; 17 (C) the name, address, and telephone number of 18 the operator; (D) the unmanned teller machine equipment 19 information, including the quantity, equipment make, equipment 20 model, and machine identification or serial number; 21 22 (E) a copy of each agreement used or intended to be used by the operator relating to the operation of the unmanned 23 24 teller machine; and 25 (F) any other relevant information that may be 26 required by the department; and

(4) except as provided by Subsection (d), be

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- 1 accompanied by the application fee under Section 282.054.
- 2 (d) The department may not charge an application fee for the
- 3 filing of a new application for an unmanned teller machine
- 4 following a material change in the registration described by
- 5 Section 282.058(a)(1)(B) or (C).
- 6 Sec. 282.054. APPLICATION FEE. (a) The finance commission
- 7 by rule shall impose a fee for filing a registration application
- 8 under Section 282.053.
- 9 (b) The application fee must be in an amount:
- 10 (1) that is at least \$5 but not more than \$25 for each
- 11 unmanned teller machine being registered;
- 12 (2) not to exceed a total of \$200, regardless of the
- 13 number of unmanned teller machines being registered; and
- 14 (3) sufficient to cover the costs of the department in
- 15 carrying out the department's duties under this chapter.
- 16 Sec. 282.055. APPROVAL OR DENIAL OF REGISTRATION;
- 17 REGISTRATION STICKER. (a) Not later than the 90th day after the
- 18 date an application for registration is filed under Section
- 19 282.053, the department shall make a determination regarding
- 20 whether to approve or deny the application. The department shall
- 21 approve the application if the application is accurate, complete,
- 22 and complies with Section 282.053.
- 23 (b) If the department approves the application, the
- 24 department shall notify the applicant of the approval and issue the
- 25 applicant a registration sticker for each unmanned teller machine
- 26 the applicant is applying to register. If the department
- 27 determines that the application is incomplete, inaccurate, or does

- 1 not comply with Section 282.053, the department shall deny the
- 2 application and notify the applicant of the reasons for denial.
- 3 (c) An application for registration that is accurate,
- 4 complete, and complies with Section 282.053 and has not been
- 5 approved or denied before the 91st day after the date the department
- 6 receives the application is considered approved for purposes of
- 7 this chapter. An operator's proof of submission of an application
- 8 described by this subsection satisfies the requirement of this
- 9 chapter to display a registration sticker for each unmanned teller
- 10 machine included in the application until the date on which the
- 11 operator is issued a registration sticker for the machine.
- 12 (d) An operator that has submitted an application
- 13 considered approved under Subsection (c) because of the
- 14 department's failure to approve or deny the application within the
- 15 period prescribed by that subsection may install and operate each
- 16 of the machines listed for registration until the date on which the
- 17 department denies the application, if ever, or the operator fails
- 18 to comply with the requirements of Section 282.058.
- 19 (e) If an application for registration considered approved
- 20 under Subsection (c) is denied at any time by the department, the
- 21 operator must uninstall and cease the operation of each unmanned
- 22 teller machine operating under that approval until the date an
- 23 application for registration of the unmanned teller machine
- 24 receives the department's approval, if ever.
- 25 <u>(f) The department has the sole discretion to determine</u>
- 26 whether a submitted application is accurate and complete for
- 27 purposes of this section.

- 1 Sec. 282.056. FORM AND CONTENTS OF REGISTRATION STICKER.
- 2 (a) The finance commission by rule shall determine the size,
- 3 design, display location, and technology used for a registration
- 4 sticker.
- 5 (b) The registration sticker, at a minimum, must include:
- 6 (1) the unmanned teller machine's identification or
- 7 <u>serial number</u>;
- 8 (2) the name, address, and telephone number of the
- 9 facility or place of business where the unmanned teller machine is
- 10 located;
- 11 (3) the name, address, and telephone number of the
- 12 occupant;
- 13 (4) the name, address, and telephone number of the
- 14 operator; and
- 15 (5) the date of issuance of the registration.
- 16 (c) An operator shall display the registration sticker
- 17 issued for each unmanned teller machine in the manner prescribed by
- 18 finance commission rule. The rules of the finance commission must
- 19 ensure that the registration sticker be displayed in a manner that
- 20 is plainly visible and readable by the public.
- 21 Sec. 282.057. REGISTRATION; VALIDITY. The registration of
- 22 an unmanned teller machine remains valid unless a material change
- 23 in the information disclosed in the registration of the machine as
- 24 described by Section 282.058 occurs and the operator of the machine
- 25 fails to comply with the requirements of that section.
- Sec. 282.058. RELOCATION OF REGISTERED MACHINE; CHANGE IN
- 27 OPERATOR OR OCCUPANT. (a) Not later than the 30th day before the

- 1 scheduled or effective date of the applicable change described by
- 2 Subdivision (1), the operator of an unmanned teller machine
- 3 registered under this chapter shall notify the department in
- 4 writing of:
- 5 (1) a material change in the information disclosed in
- 6 the registration of the machine because of:
- 7 (A) the relocation of the machine to another
- 8 place of business or facility if a change of ownership has not
- 9 occurred;
- 10 (B) a new occupant or operator of the machine; or
- 11 (C) a new lessee or lessor of the machine; and
- 12 (2) the scheduled or effective date of the applicable
- 13 change described by Subdivision (1).
- 14 (b) Not later than the 60th day after the scheduled or
- 15 effective date of a material change in the registration of an
- 16 unmanned teller machine described by Subsection (a)(1), the
- 17 operator of the machine must:
- 18 (1) file a new application for registration of the
- 19 machine under Section 282.053 if the change occurs because of
- 20 Subsection (a)(1)(B) or (C); or
- 21 (2) submit a request for written approval of the
- 22 transfer of the registration under Section 282.059 if the change
- 23 occurs because of Subsection (a)(1)(A).
- (c) If the operator required to file a new application or
- 25 submit a request for transfer approval under Subsection (b) fails
- 26 to do so within the time prescribed by that subsection, the operator
- 27 must uninstall and cease operation of the machine, unless the

- 1 department grants the operator an extension of time.
- 2 Sec. 282.059. TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION. (a) An unmanned
- 3 teller machine registration may be transferred following a
- 4 relocation of the machine described by Section 282.058(a)(1)(A)
- 5 only with the written approval of the department.
- 6 (b) The finance commission by rule may prescribe
- 7 registration transfer procedures and may prescribe forms to be used
- 8 for issuance of new registration stickers.
- 9 Sec. 282.060. OPERATION OF MACHINE WITHOUT REGISTRATION
- 10 STICKER PROHIBITED. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this
- 11 chapter, an operator of an unmanned teller machine subject to
- 12 registration violates this chapter if the operator places the
- 13 machine in operation without a valid registration sticker.
- 14 (b) Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, an
- 15 occupant violates this chapter if the occupant permits an unmanned
- 16 <u>teller machine subject to registration to be placed in the premises</u>
- 17 of a business establishment or facility owned or operated by the
- 18 occupant without a valid registration sticker.
- 19 SUBCHAPTER C. ENFORCEMENT
- Sec. 282.101. CIVIL PENALTY; INJUNCTIVE RELIEF. (a) A
- 21 person that violates this chapter or a rule adopted under this
- 22 chapter is liable to this state for a civil penalty in an amount of
- 23 not less than \$50 or more than \$500 for each violation. Each day of a
- 24 continuing violation is a separate violation. The amount of the
- 25 civil penalty imposed under this subsection may not exceed \$2,000
- 26 in the aggregate for the violation and all violations of a similar
- 27 <u>nature.</u>

- 1 (b) The attorney general may bring an action in the name of
- 2 this state against a person that violates this chapter or a rule
- 3 adopted under this chapter for:
- 4 (1) injunctive relief;
- 5 (2) recovery of a civil penalty imposed under this
- 6 section; or
- 7 (3) both injunctive relief and a civil penalty.
- 8 <u>(c) An action under this section may be brought in a</u>
- 9 <u>district court in:</u>
- 10 <u>(1) Travis County; or</u>
- 11 (2) a county in which any part of the violation or
- 12 threatened violation occurs.
- SECTION 2. (a) Not later than January 1, 2022, the Finance
- 14 Commission of Texas shall adopt rules to administer and implement
- 15 Chapter 282, Finance Code, as added by this Act, including rules to
- 16 establish the unmanned teller machine registry required by Section
- 17 282.051, Finance Code, as added by this Act.
- 18 (b) Notwithstanding Chapter 282, Finance Code, as added by
- 19 this Act, an operator of an unmanned teller machine that is subject
- 20 to registration under that chapter and that was not in operation on
- 21 or before the effective date of this Act is not required to file an
- 22 application to register the unmanned teller machine until January
- 23 1, 2022.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the
- 25 operator of an unmanned teller machine that was in operation before
- 26 the effective date of this Act and is subject to the registration
- 27 requirements of Chapter 282, Finance Code, as added by this Act,

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- 1 must file an application to register the machine in accordance with
- 2 that chapter not later than January 1, 2023.
- 3 SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 4 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
- 5 (b) Section 282.101, Finance Code, as added by this Act,
- 6 takes effect January 1, 2023.
