1-15 relating to licensing examinations for certain court interpreters.  
1-16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-17 SECTION 1. Section 157.103(c), Government Code, is amended  
1-18 to read as follows:  
1-19 (c) Examinations shall be offered:  
1-20 (1) in person in each county with a population of  
1-21 800,000 or more [the state] at least once [twice] a year at times  
1-22 and places designated by the director; or  
1-23 (2) in person at times and places designated by the  
1-24 director, if any, and online at least twice a year at times  
1-25 designated by the director.  
1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2022.
