A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the creation and optional filing of a record of life for
3 an unborn child and the use of a certificate of stillbirth;
4 authorizing fees.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 192, Health and Safety
7 Code, is amended to read as follows:

8 CHAPTER 192. BIRTH AND LIFE RECORDS

9 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 192, Health and Safety
10 Code, is amended by adding Section 192.0023 to read as follows:

11 Sec. 192.0023. OPTIONAL REGISTRATION OF LIFE; LIFE
12 CERTIFICATE. (a) In this section, "unborn child" has the meaning
13 assigned by Section 171.061.

14 (b) An unborn child's parent at the parent's discretion may,
15 if the parent resides in this state, request a life certificate for
16 the unborn child under this section before the unborn child's
17 birth.

18 (c) The department shall prescribe the form and content of
19 the life certificate and shall specify the information necessary to
20 prepare the certificate. The form must include separate spaces for
21 recording:

22 (1) the name of the unborn child;

23 (2) the date the unborn child's life is acknowledged;

24 and

1 (3) the date the unborn child is born.

2 (d) The parent who requests the life certificate may provide
3 a name for the unborn child to be listed on the life certificate. If
4 the parent does not wish to provide a name, the vital statistics
5 unit shall fill in the certificate with the name "baby boy" or "baby
6 girl" and the last name of the parent.

7 (e) On request of an unborn child's parent, a physician or
8 advanced practice registered nurse shall file the life certificate
9 with the local registrar of the registration district in which the
10 parent resides. The life certificate must be accompanied by an
11 affidavit signed by the physician or nurse attesting to the life of
12 the unborn child based on a sonogram or other appropriate physical
13 examination of the unborn child's mother.

14 (f) A parent may request an amendment to the life
15 certificate after the unborn child's birth to add the child's date
16 of birth or add or amend the child's name.

17 (g) A local registrar shall collect, record, preserve,
18 search for, issue copies of, and assess copy fees for a life
19 certificate in the same manner as provided for birth certificates
20 and in accordance with department rules.

21 (h) The parents of an unborn child may use the life
22 certificate of an unborn child filed under this section in the same
23 manner and for the same purposes provided for birth certificates
24 under law and as provided by department rules.

25 (i) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules to
26 implement this section.

27 SECTION 3. Section [192.0022](#)(f), Health and Safety Code, is

1 repealed.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
