4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 17, Utilities Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 17.011 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 17.011. NOTICE REQUIRED FOR INTENTIONAL OUTAGES. Not
8	later than three hours after an electric utility, municipally owned
9	utility, or electric cooperative intentionally shuts off electric
10	power to a customer in response to an emergency event, the utility
11	or cooperative shall notify the customer of the shutoff by e-mail or
12	text message. The notice must include the following information:
13	(1) the estimated time and date that the utility or
14	cooperative will restore electric power to the customer; and
15	(2) whether the shutoff is part of a rolling outage.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended
17	by adding Section 13.1397 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 13.1397. NOTICE REQUIRED FOR INTENTIONAL SHUTOFF OF
19	SERVICE. Not later than three hours after a retail public utility
20	intentionally shuts off water service to a customer in response to
21	an emergency event, the utility shall notify the customer of the
22	shutoff by e-mail or text message. The notice must include the
23	estimated time and date that the utility will restore water service

24 to the customer.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
