5	SECTION 1. Section 801.260, Occupations Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 801.260. <u>REQUIREMENTS TO PERFORM</u> [LICENSE REQUIRED
8	\overline{FOR}] EQUINE DENTISTRY. A person may not perform equine dentistry or
9	offer or attempt to act as an equine dental provider unless the
10	person is:
11	(1) a veterinarian who is active and in good standing;
12	[or]
13	(2) a licensed equine dental provider who is active
14	and in good standing performing under the supervision of a
15	veterinarian who is active and in good standing; or
16	(3) a student of an equine dental provider
17	certification program approved by the board who:
18	(A) is completing the practical requirements of
19	the certification program; and
20	(B) performs equine dentistry under the direct
21	supervision of a veterinarian who is active and in good standing.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
