1-19 relating to the performance of equine dentistry by students of
 1-20 equine dental provider certification programs.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 801.260, Occupations Code, is amended to
 1-23 read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 801.260. REQUIREMENTS TO PERFORM [~~LICENSE REQUIRED~~
 1-25 ~~FOR~~] EQUINE DENTISTRY. A person may not perform equine dentistry or
 1-26 offer or attempt to act as an equine dental provider unless the
 1-27 person is:

1-28 (1) a veterinarian who is active and in good standing;
 1-29 [~~or~~]

1-30 (2) a licensed equine dental provider who is active
 1-31 and in good standing performing under the supervision of a
 1-32 veterinarian who is active and in good standing; or

1-33 (3) a student of an equine dental provider
 1-34 certification program approved by the board who:

1-35 (A) is completing the practical requirements of
 1-36 the certification program; and

1-37 (B) performs equine dentistry under the direct
 1-38 supervision of a veterinarian who is active and in good standing.

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
