- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 151, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 151.004 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.004. FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS OF PARENTS. (a) A parent
- 8 is presumed to be a fit parent who acts in the best interest of his
- 9 or her child.
- 10 (b) The fundamental right of a parent to raise his or her
- 11 child includes but is not limited to the right to direct and make
- 12 decisions for the care, custody, control, education, upbringing,
- 13 moral and religious training, and medical care of the child.
- 14 (c) In a suit between a parent and a non-parent, a parent who
- 15 has suffered an infringement of his or her fundamental right under
- 16 subsection (b) by a non-parent may raise subsection (d) as a
- 17 defense.
- 18 (d) A court may not order any relief that conflicts with a
- 19 parent's fundamental right under Subsection (b) unless the court
- 20 finds that the requested relief is necessary to prevent a
- 21 significant impairment of the child's physical health or emotional
- 22 well-being.
- (e) This section may not be construed to limit the rights of
- 24 the state, including the right to investigate or act on a report of

- 1 <u>child abuse or neglect allegedly committed by a person responsible</u>
- 2 for a child's care, custody, or welfare, beyond the limitations
- 3 required by the United States Constitution.
- 4 <u>(f)</u> This section does not apply to an action for child
- 5 support.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
